

REWARD STRUCTURE

STRUCTURE 1 BLUE MERIT CARDS

Students are rewarded with blue merit cards for academic, social, and personal reasons for playground, classroom and non classroom settings. Classroom expectations displayed in all classrooms on stars.

Children keep their merit cards until they have collected a multiple of ten and then hand them to DP who organises the award to be given out at the next Assembly.

- 10 blue merits - 1 white merit card
- 20 blue merits - 1 large certificate
- 30 blue merits - 1 ribbon and photo displayed
- 40 blue merits – 1 APS pen
- 50 blue merits - 1 student award badge
- 60 blue merits – 1 engraved medallion

STRUCTURE 2 PLAYGROUND TOKENS

Students receive making good choices tokens in the playground during lunchtimes for positive behaviour. The tokens are then handed in to class teachers who at the conclusion of 2 weeks write totals down on a collection sheet. **The winning class each fortnight who collected the most tokens is announced at Assembly and rewarded with bonus time in the technology room or playground equipment.** The winning class is also acknowledged in School Newsletter.

STRUCTURE 3 GREENSLIP DAY

During each term coloured slips are issued if a student breaks school rules in the classroom and/or the playground. If children receive no orange or red slips during the term they are rewarded at the end of the term with a small green certificate and an iceblock. If children receive no orange or red slips for the whole semester they are rewarded at the end of the semester with a large green certificate, an iceblock and **1 hours free play.**

STRUCTURE 4 ASSEMBLY AWARDS

Each fortnight at Assembly each class selects 2 award winners to receive awards. The first award is the Certificate of Merit for outstanding academic or social contribution. The second award is the PBIS award which acknowledges a student who is making good choices in relation to their behaviour and attitude. All winners are published in School Newsletters.

STRUCTURE 5 PRESENTATION DAY

At the end of the year the children can be rewarded with Banners or books to acknowledge academic effort, improvement, citizenship, sporting ability and various other areas. **All winners are acknowledged in souvenir programs.**

STRUCTURE 6 PRINCIPALS AWARDS

The Principal gives special awards directly to students who are sent to her/him for great work and/or making good choices.
